to use the waters of McKENZIE RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70107. The date of priority is OCTOBER 25, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 4.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 20, T 17 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 560 FEET NORTH AND 512 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 20.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before FEBRUARY 9, 1991, completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992. *BC extended to 10-1-94, 10-1-99*

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
