PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

U.S. FREMONT NATIONAL FOREST

to use the waters of COFFEEPOT CREEK, a tributary of CHEWAUCAN RIVER,  
for ROAD WATERING FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE.

This Permit is issued approving Application 59969. The date of  
priority is APRIL 11, 1980. The use is limited to not more than 0.09  
ACRE-FOOT (30,000 GALLONS PER YEAR) or its equivalent in case of  
rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 35 S, R 17 E, W.M.; 2350 FEET NORTH AND  
580 FEET EAST FROM S 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 12.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be  
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as  
follows:

ROAD 3431

SECTIONS 12 AND 13  
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

SECTION 18  
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 23, 1991,  
and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete  
application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October  
1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result  
in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil  
penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The  
water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best  
practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in  
compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged  
land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water  
is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for  
maintaining instream flows.
