PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of BEAR FLAT DRAW,
for ROAD WATERING FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE.

This Permit is issued approving Application 60019. The date of
priority is APRIL 11, 1980. The use is limited to not more than 0.92
ACRE-FOOT (300,000 GALLONS PER YEAR) or its equivalent in case of
rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 27 S, R 11 E, W.M.; 1584 FEET SOUTH AND
1188 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 10.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as
follows:

ROADS 2624, 2415 AND 2726

SECTIONS 28, 32 AND 33
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

SECTIONS
3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 21, 22, 24, 27, 34 AND 35
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

SECTIONS 2, 3, 10, 11, 13, 14 AND 24
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 23, 1991,
and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete
application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October
1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result
in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil
penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The
water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best
practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in
compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged
land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water
is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for
maintaining instream flows.
