PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of TWO UNNAMED STREAMS, tributaries of NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, and NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, a tributary of COQUILLE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 18.3 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN OR NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69738. The date of priority is OCTOBER 18, 1988. The use is limited to not more than 0.233 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.0015 CFS from Stream 1 and 0.0015 CFS from Stream 2 for domestic use and 0.23 CFS from the River for irrigation of 18.3 acres, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 27 S, R 11 W, W.M.; SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 26 S, R 11 W, W.M.; STREAM 1 - 227 FEET SOUTH AND 454 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33; STREAM 2 - 1186 FEET SOUTH AND 1080 FEET EAST; RIVER - 3 FEET NORTH AND 1200 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.7 ACRE
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.2 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 7.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 NW 1/4 6.4 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before MARCH 9, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
