to use the waters of UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 25.5 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70096. The date of priority is OCTOBER 13, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.32 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 29, T 24 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 370 FEET NORTH AND 440 FEET EAST FROM S 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 19.4 ACRES  
LOT 3 (SW 1/3 SE 1/4) 6.1 ACRES  
SECTION 29  
TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before MARCH 9, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
