PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

OREGON PLACER, INC.
PO BOX 858
RIDDLE, OREGON 97469

to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for WASHING GRAVEL FOR GOLD RECOVERY.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70180. The date of priority is JANUARY 29, 1990. The use is limited to the period October 1 through July 14 of each year and to not more than 1.34 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 18, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 272 FEET NORTH AND 610 FEET EAST FROM E 1/16 CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 18.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This permit is subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before MARCH 12, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1992.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
