to use the waters of WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 299.9 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 97.3 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 68709. The dates of priority ARE LISTED IN THE TABULATION BELOW. The use is limited to not more than 4.97 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 6 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 4700 FEET NORTH AND 1290 FEET EAST FROM SE CORNER, DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This permit shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior permit for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
