PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of A SPRING, with any deficiency in the available supply to be appropriated from MELTON CREEK, a tributary of TUCKER CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70141. The date of priority is DECEMBER 11, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 13, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 28 S, R 5 W, W.M.; SPRING - 830 FEET SOUTH AND 710 FEET WEST; CREEK - 970 FEET NORTH AND 830 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 13.

The right allowed herein shall be limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to human consumption, livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family and irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before APRIL 30, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
