to use the waters of DRY PRAIRIE CREEK and SAGEHORN RESERVOIR, to be constructed under Application R-69659, Permit R-11220, a tributary of LOST RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 124.4 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69725. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1988. The use is limited to not more than 1.56 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 1.55 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.01 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22; SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27; NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 34, T 37 S, R 13 E, W.M.; RESERVOIR - 270 FEET NORTH AND 850 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 22; CREEK - 1595 FEET SOUTH AND 2125 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 27 AND 950 FEET SOUTH AND 1385 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Water may not be appropriated from direct flow after June 1 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
