THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of TWO UNNAMED STREAMS AND RESERVOIR constructed under Permit R-1946, tributaries of COQUILLE RIVER, for TEMPERATURE CONTROL, FLOOD HARVESTING AND IRRIGATION OF 17.3 ACRES OF CRANBERRIES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69892. The dates of priority are MAY 11, 1989 FOR TWO STREAMS AND DECEMBER 29, 1989 FOR WATER STORED IN THE RESERVOIR. The use is limited to not more than 0.519 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.086 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, 0.519 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL, AND 0.173 CFS FOR FLOOD HARVESTING, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 4, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 730 FEET SOUTH AND 1220 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 4; 50 FEET NORTH AND 290 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 4.

The irrigation of cranberries is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTLETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The irrigation of any other crop is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

Supplemental from Unnamed Stream 2 for irrigation, temperature control and flood harvesting, supplemented by Unnamed Stream 1 for temperature control and flood harvesting on:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.6 ACRES NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.7 ACRES NW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 ACRES

Supplemental from Unnamed Stream 2 supplemented by Unnamed Stream 1 and Reservoir for irrigation, temperature control and flood harvesting on:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.8 ACRES NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.2 ACRE

Primary from Unnamed Stream 2 supplemented by Unnamed Stream 1 and Reservoir for irrigation, temperature control and flood harvesting on:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 8.0 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 ACRES

Actual construction work shall begin on or before MAY 18, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
