PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributaries of UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY FROM THE STREAM AND SUPPLEMENTAL DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN FROM NORTH UMPQUA RIVER.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70131. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 28, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 500.0 GALLONS PER DAY FROM THE STREAM FOR DOMESTIC USE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE SUPPLY TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, NOT TO EXCEED 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR SUPPLEMENTAL DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 16, T 26 S, R 3 W, W.M.; STREAM - 1670 FEET SOUTH AND 1210 FEET EAST; RIVER - 1600 FEET SOUTH AND 260 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 16.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JUNE 18, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use granted herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
