PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of COX GULCH, a tributary of NORTH MYRTLE CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70167. The date of priority is JANUARY 4, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 23, T 28 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 15 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 23.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4  
SECTION 23  
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right allowed herein shall be limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to human consumption, livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JUNE 18, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
