to use the waters of LONG CREEK, a tributary of SYCAN RIVER, for ROAD WATERING.

This Permit is issued approving Application 60016. The date of priority is APRIL 11, 1980. The use is limited to not more than 500,000 GALLONS PER YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 34, T 32 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 2244 FEEL SOUTH AND 1584 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 34.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

SECTIONS 21, 28, AND 34 TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M.

SECTIONS 2, 3, 11, AND 12 TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JUNE 25, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
