PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of SHOESTRING CREEK, a tributary of KLAMATH MARSH, for ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE.

This Permit is issued approving Application 66590. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 21, 1983. The use is limited to not more than 1.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND NOT TO EXCEED 3.0 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 28 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 1500 FEET NORTH AND 200 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

SECTIONS 24, 25, 35 AND 36  
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 8 EAST, W.M.

SECTIONS 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 AND 32  
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

SECTION 1  
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 8 EAST, W.M.

SECTIONS 4, 5 AND 6  
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before JUNE 25, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
