PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, tributaries of COQUILLE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70328. The date of priority is APRIL 27, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.0096 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.002 CFS FROM STREAM FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.0076 CFS FROM RIVER FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the sources.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 27 S, R 11 W, W.M.; STREAM - 1299 FEET SOUTH AND 621 FEET WEST; RIVER - 1061 FEET SOUTH AND 611 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.5 ACRES & DOMESTIC
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before AUGUST 20, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
