to use the waters of APPLEGATE RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-7810, a tributary of APPLEGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 5.4 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70206. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 10.0 ACREFEET ANNUALLY OF STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the river.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

RIVER NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 37 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1050 FEET SOUTH AND 1390 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 19; RESERVOIR - S 1/2 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, W.M.

For the irrigation of containerized nursery plants, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre feet per acre per year. For the irrigation of in-ground nursery plants the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre feet per acre per year. The use of water for nursery crops may be at any time of the year that the use is beneficial. For the irrigation of any other crop, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.2 ACRE
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.9 ACRE
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 3.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.3 ACRES

The use of water under this permit is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 0-07-10-W0791 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 19, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
