PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED DRAIN, a tributary of UMATILLA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 78.2 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 68587. The date of priority is OCTOBER 8, 1985. THE USE IS LIMITED TO THE PERIOD FROM MARCH 1 THROUGH MAY 31 EACH YEAR AND not more than 0.98 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 11, T 3 N, R 28 E, W.M.; 210 FEET SOUTH AND 870 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

In the interest of conserving groundwater, this permit may be exercised to satisfy the primary right provided that the total quantity of water diverted from all sources does not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 36.0 ACRES
SECTION 10

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 15.4 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 26.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.4 ACRE

SECTION 11
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 26, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
