PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of UPPER SAGEBRUSH DRAW AND LOWER SAGEBRUSH DRAW, tributaries of BEAR CREEK DRAW, for ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE.

This permit is issued approving Application 66587. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 21, 1983. The use is limited to not more than 2.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND; BEING 1.0 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE NOT TO EXCEED 3.0 ACRES OF WATER FROM EACH SOURCE EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

UPPER SAGEBRUSH DRAW - NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 27 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 1600 FEET NORTH AND 2200 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 15.

LOWER SAGEBRUSH DRAW - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 23, T 27 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 2000 FEET NORTH AND 1900 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 23.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14,
15, 16, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 AND 36
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 7, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
