PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of THRUSH CREEK AND TWO RESERVOIRS, to be constructed under Application R-70671, Permit R-11348, tributaries of COQUILLE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.5 ACRE AND CRANBERRY OPERATIONS ON 8.0 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70672. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 20, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 1.2 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the sources.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 3, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 230 FEET SOUTH AND 630 FEET EAST; 560 FEET SOUTH AND 1200 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 3.

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre. For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre. For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	7.5 ACRES	CRANBERRY OPERATIONS
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	0.5 ACRE	CRANBERRY OPERATIONS

TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.		

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 19, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
