to use the waters of NORTH SANTIAM RIVER AND DETROIT RESREVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.7 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70846. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 1, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.033 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 9 S, R 2 E, W.M.; 415 FEET SOUTH AND 110 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 31.

DETROIT RESERVOIR - SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 10 S, R 5 E, W.M.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage

The water user shall comply with the terms and conditions of Contract # 1-07-10-W0827 dated 26 day of February, 1991. between Bureau Of Reclamation and James L. Girod. A copy of the contract is in Application File # 70846 at the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.7 ACRES SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 25, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.
