THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of UNNAMED SPRING # 2, a tributary of ALSEA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR FIVE FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN FOR EACH.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70848. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 1, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 8 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 32, T 13 S, R 10 W, W.M.; 1044.92 FEET NORTH AND 2087.30 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

LOT 9 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4) DOMESTIC TWO FAMILIES
LOT 8 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) DOMESTIC THREE FAMILIES
SECTION 32

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 10 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 25, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
