to use the waters of RAINY CREEK, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY TO BE MADE UP FROM GATE CREEK, CABIN CREEK, DITCH CREEK AND DEADPOINT CREEK, UPPER AND LOWER GREENPOINT RESERVOIRS, constructed under Permit R-698, tributaries of HOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 160.0 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69887. The date of priority is APRIL 27, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 2.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the sources.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

RAINEY CREEK - NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 2 N, R 8 E, W.M.; 2120 FEET NORTH AND 860 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 25;

GATE CREEK - NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 6940 FEET NORTH AND 14,820 FEET WEST; 6820 FEET NORTH AND 14,720 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM SE CORNER, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 34;

CABIN CREEK - SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 4400 FEET NORTH AND 8100 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 34;

UPPER GREENPOINT RESERVOIR - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 2800 FEET SOUTH AND 1950 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 22;

DEADPOINT CREEK - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 34, T 2 N, R 9 E, W.M.; 4700 FEET NORTH AND 2820 FEET WEST; 5110 FEET NORTH AND 1060 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 34;

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
