PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of WOAHPINK LAKE, a tributary of WOAHPINK CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 13.2 ACRES AND PARK USE.

This permit is issued approving Application 71107. The date of priority is JANUARY 10, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 0.245 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.165 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.080 CFS FOR PARK USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DIVERSION POINT 1 (IRRIGATION) - NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 14, T 19 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 1025 FEET SOUTH AND 1045 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 14; DIVERSION POINT 2 (PARK USE) - NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 14, T 19 S, R 12, W, W.M.; 610 FEET SOUTH AND 110 FEET EAST FROM E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 5, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
