## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of DRAINAGEWAYS 1, 2, 3, UNNAMED STREAM, UNNAMED SWALES 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, RESERVOIRS A, B, C, D, and E constructed under Permit R-11367, SPRINGS 1, 4, AND THE UMPQUA RIVER, tributaries of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 38.624 ACRES, SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 56.5 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES.

This permit is issued approving Application 69572. The date of priority is JUNE 14, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 1.334 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
