to use the waters of FALL RIVER, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for FISH CULTURE.

This permit is issued approving Application 71148. The date of priority is JANUARY 25, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 17.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 20 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 340 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET EAST FROM C 1/4 CORNER SECTION 31.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

This development was reviewed and approved by the Water Resources Commission on April 19, 1991.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 22, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
