to use the waters of SANTIAM RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 298.5 ACRES.

This permit is issued approving Application 71292. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 14, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 3.73 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 10 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 3862 FEET NORTH AND 790 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 20, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.
