PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

to use the waters of LOST CREEK RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8142, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 26.2 ACRES.

This permit is issued approving Application 71362. The date of priority is MARCH 14, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 100.0 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

RIVER - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 34 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1225 FEET SOUTH AND 2505 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 10.

LOST CREEK RESERVOIR - NW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 33 S, R 1 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The water user shall comply with the terms and conditions of contract 1-07-10-W0840 dated May 6, 1991 between Bureau Of Reclamation and Dan E. Bunn. A copy of the contract is in Application File #71362 at the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4	4.0 ACRES
SECTION 3	
NE 1/4 NW 1/4	9.8 ACRES
NW 1/4 NW 1/4	10.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	2.0 ACRES
SECTION 10	
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.	

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 1, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

*B EXT to 10-1-94 / B+C to 10-1-95, 10-1-96*  
This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
