PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributaries of UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70628. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 6, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.009 CFS FROM NORTH UMPQUA RIVER AND 0.001 CFS FROM UNNAMED STREAM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the sources.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 16, T 26 S, R 3 W, W.M.; RIVER - 1770 FEET SOUTH AND 60 FEET EAST; STREAM - 1670 FEET SOUTH AND 1210 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 16.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4  
SECTION 16  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 15, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
