to use the waters of BIG CREEK, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for FISH CULTURE.

This permit is issued approving Application 71489. The date of priority is APRIL 5, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 10.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. No water may be appropriated during the period June 1 through October 31.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 8 N, R 7 W, W.M.; 908 FEET NORTH AND 462 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29.

The water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 8 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

This development was reviewed and approved by the Water Resources Commission on August 22, 1991.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 26, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
