to use the waters of JIM CREEK, a tributary of FLORAS CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR ONE FAMILY.

This permit is issued approving Application 71379. The date of priority is MARCH 21, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 31 S, R 15 W, W.M.; DIVERSION POINT 1 - 1180 FEET SOUTH AND 80 FEET WEST, DIVERSION POINT 2 - 630 FEET SOUTH AND 660 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 10.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 10
TOWNSHIP 31 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 30, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
