PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of NORTH SANTIAM RIVER AND DETROIT RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 280.70 ACRES.

This permit is issued approving Application 69054. The date of priority is APRIL 10, 1987. The use is limited to not more than 3.52 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DETROIT RESERVOIR - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 10 S, R 5 E, W.M.; RIVER - LOT 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 11, 9 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 1800 FEET SOUTH AND 2830 FEET EAST FROM W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from live flow and storage.

The water user shall comply with the terms and conditions of contract 7-07-10-WO675 between Santiam Water Control District and Bureau of Reclamation. A copy of the contract is in Application File #69054 at the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 14, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
