PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70381. The date of priority is MAY 29, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. It is further provided that the right allowed herein shall be limited during the period of July 1 through October 31 of each year to human consumption, livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family and irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 30 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 830 FEET NORTH AND 2390 FEET WEST FROM E 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 29.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 3, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1995.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
