## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

TERRY AND BARBARA WATSON 3541 DEL RIO ROAD ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 7.37 ACRES.

This permit is issued approving Application 71659. The date of priority is JUNE 6, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 0.0921 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. Water may only be appropriated during the period March 1 through July 15 of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 350 FEET SOUTH AND 800 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 27.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.39 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 5.98 ACRES
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 23, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1995.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
