## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, PANTHER CREEK, AND A UNNAMED RESERVOIR, to be constructed under Application R-70282, Permit R-11457, tributaries of NORTH YAMHILL RIVER, for IRRIGATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 95.0 ACRES AND RECREATION.

This Permit is issued approving Application 70283. The date of priority is APRIL 9, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 1.18 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FROM UNNAMED STREAM WIH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE SUPPLY TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM PANTHER CREEK FROM MARCH 1 TO APRIL 30, AND 8.5 ACREFEET OF STORED WATER ONLY FROM RESERVOIR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 4, T 4 S, R 4 W, W.M.; PANTHER CREEK - 1200 FEET NORTH AND 370 FEET EAST; UNNAMED STREAM - 880 FEET NORTH AND 540 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM W 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 4.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:
