PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-67984, PERMIT R-10482 TO BE ENLARGED UNDER APPLICATION R- 71578, PERMIT R-11459, a tributary of ASH SWALE, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 80.0 ACRES OR FISH CULTURE.

This permit is issued approving Application 71579. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 30.0 ACRE- FEET STORED WATER ONLY FOR IRRIGATION OR FISH CULTURE AND 0.3 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND OF WATER FOR MAINTENANCE OF RESERVOIR FOR FISH CULTURE FROM THE PERIOD OF NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH APRIL 30 OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 6 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 305 FEET NORTH AND 2700 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 2.5 acre-feet stored for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 2, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1995.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
