to use the waters of JOHNSON CREEK, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, and reservoir constructed under Application R-69929, Permit R-11465 for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS ON 12.0 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69930. The date of priority is JUNE 1, 1989. The use is limited to not more than 4.0 ACRE-FEET and 1.8 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. Water may be appropriated from live flow only during November 1 through June 30 of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 29 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 220 FEET NORTH AND 50 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 6.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The water user is required to install and maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre; For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre; For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the Permit is as follows:

NE1/4 NE1/4 12.0 ACRES SECTION 7 TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 17, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1995.
