to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, HOGAN CREEK, AND RESERVOIRS C & D, CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-71638, PERMIT R-11469, tributaries of JOHNSON CREEK, for PRIMARY AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 130.42 ACRES AND MAINTAINENCE OF RESERVOIRS A & B FOR AESTHETICS.

This permit is issued approving Application 71639. The date of priority is MAY 24, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 1.85 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND(CFS), BEING 1.63 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.22 CFS FOR MAINTAINENCE OF PONDS FOR AESTHETICS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The appropriation of water from direct flow is limited to the period of December 1 through June 1 of each year.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

HOGAN CREEK - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 23, T 1 S, R 3 E, W.M.

UNNAMED STREAM - E 1/2 SE 1/4, SECTION 23, T 1 S, R 3 E, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4	30.69 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	33.97 ACRES & AESTHETICS
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	2.31 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4	31.07 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 17, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1996.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
