PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 41.0 ACRES.

This Permit is issued approving Application 69405. The date of priority is OCTOBER 14, 1987. The use is limited to not more than 0.51 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 8, T 30 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1100 FEET NORTH AND 160 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year except for irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre noncommercial garden.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this Permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	17.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	10.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4	1.8 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	12.0 ACRES
SECTION 8	
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.	

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 28, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1995.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
