to use the waters of QUARTZ SPRING, a tributary of QUARTZ CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK USE (9 RV SPACES).

This permit is issued approving Application 69656. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1988. The use is limited to not more than 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.015 CFS FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK USES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 37 S, R 16 E, W.M.; 250 FEET NORTH AND 640 FEET EAST FROM S 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 27.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP, 37 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 28, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1994. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1995.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
