## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

ROBERT A. AND ALICE JANETTE BELL 3635 AVENUE G WHITE CITY, OREGON 97503

to use the waters of LOST CREEK RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8142, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.3 ACRES.

This permit is issued approving Application 73231. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 4, 1993. The use is limited to not more than 5.75 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOST CREEK RESERVOIR - SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 33 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 2000 FEET SOUTH AND 1700 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 26.

RIVER - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 36 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 2640 FEET SOUTH AND 110 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The period of allowed use is April 1 through October 31.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.6 ACRE SECTION 18 TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.7 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

Measurement recording and reporting conditions:

A. The Director may require the permittee to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the permittee to install a meter or other measuring device, the permittee shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

B. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 4-07-10-W0996 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 24, 1995 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996. Complete application of water shall be made on or before October 1, 1997.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director of the Water Resources Department has found that the proposed use of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
