to use the waters of SPRINGS 1 and 2, tributaries of NESTUCCA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR THREE FAMILIES DURING THE PERIOD OF MAY AND JUNE; HUMAN CONSUMPTION DURING JULY THROUGH APRIL EACH YEAR.

This permit is issued approving Application 72453. The dates of priority are JUNE 12, 1992 for use from Spring 1 and July 29, 1992 from Spring 2. The use is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND from Spring 1 with any deficiency in the supply to be appropriated from Spring 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 3, T 4 S, R 8 W, W.M.; SPRING 1 - NORTH 67 DEGREES 39 MINUTES EAST 723.7 FEET, SPRING 2 - NORTH 73 DEGREES 38 MINUTES EAST 363.0 FEET, BOTH FROM THE CENTER SOUTH 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 3
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December , 1995 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996. Complete application of water shall be made on or before October 1, 1997.

The water storage structure shall be sited as close to the source spring as is practical. All overflow water shall be returned to the normal discharge channel of the spring. Spring-water not used or stored shall remain in the existing natural channel.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director of the Water Resources Department has found that the proposed use of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
