PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND MILLICOMA RIVER, tributaries of COOS RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 40.0 ACRES AND STOCKWATER.

This permit is issued approving Application 72648. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 2, 1992. The use is limited to not more than 0.505 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FROM UNNAMED STREAM FOR LIVESTOCK WATER AND 0.5 CFS FROM MILLICOMA RIVER FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 6, SECTION 13, T 25 S, R 12 W, W.M.; UNNAMED STREAM - 1795 .5 FEET NORTH AND 1992.1 FEET EAST, RIVER - 1315.5 FEET NORTH AND 2320 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The required screens and by-pass devices are to be in place, functional, inspected and approved by an ODFW representative prior to diversion of any water.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under this permit is as follows:

LOT 4 0.7 ACRE
LOT 5 6.5 ACRES
LOT 6 22.2 ACRES
LOT 7 10.6 ACRES

SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before DECEMBER 20, 1995 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1997.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
