SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF WEST FORK MILLICOMA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR TWO HOUSEHOLDS INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF ONE-HALF ACRE NON-COMMERCIAL LAWN AND GARDEN, FURTHER LIMITED DURING THE PERIOD LISTED BELOW TO HUMAN CONSUMPTION USE ONLY

RATE OF USE: 0.01 CFS

PERIOD OF ALLOWED USE: DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO HOUSEHOLDS INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE FROM DECEMBER 1 THROUGH MARCH 31 AND FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.005 CFS FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION ONLY FROM APRIL 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30.

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 23, 1992

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T24S, R11W, W.M.; POD 1: 180 FEET SOUTH AND 150 FEET WEST; POD 2: 310 FEET SOUTH AND 545 FEET WEST; POD 3: 435 FEET SOUTH AND 725 FEET WEST; POD 4: 450 FEET SOUTH AND 725 FEET WEST; POD 5: 570 FEET SOUTH AND 825 FEET WEST, ALL FROM THE C 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

Measurement recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the permittee to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the permittee to install a meter or other measuring device, the permittee shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such

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installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

- B. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility at the time of perfection of this right.

The permittee shall install, operate and maintain all fish screening devices required by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish entering any diversion of water created by this appropriation of water from this unnamed stream. The permittee shall install and have such screening approved by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife before any water is appropriated under this permit.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.


The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1996, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1999.

This permit is issued to reaffirm the approval of Application S-72271 as limited by the conditions contained herein. Permit 51908 is superseded by this instrument and is of no further force or effect.
