SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, WITH ANY DEFICIENCIES TO BE MADE UP FROM NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF UMPQUA RIVER, AND "THE BENCH" RESERVOIR TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-70083, PERMIT R-11917

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 21.1 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE/VOLUME ALLOWED: 0.264 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM AND NORTH UMPQUA RIVER; 9.1 ACRE-FEET (AF) PER YEAR FROM "THE BENCH" RESERVOIR

PERIOD OF USE: LIVE FLOW - APRIL 1 THROUGH JUNE 15 AND SEPTEMBER 16 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30; STORED WATER - APRIL 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 29, 1989 FOR 0.264 CFS AND 3.0 AF, AND MARCH 8, 1991 FOR 3.1 AF

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 13, T26S, R4E, W.M.; UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIR - 380 FEET NORTH & 790 FEET EAST, NORTH UMPQUA RIVER - 1250 FEET NORTH & 2490 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 13

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

## Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion on the North Umpqua River. The permittee shall not construct, operate or maintain any dam or artificial obstruction to fish passage in the channel of North Umpqua River unless a fishway is provided. The applicant is hereby directed to contact a ODFW Fish Passage Program coordinator, Portland, Oregon, before beginning construction of any in-channel obstruction.

**STANDARD CONDITIONS**

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction work shall begin within one year from permit issuance and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1999.
