APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: S-76871

SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF MIDDLE CREEK, AND MIDDLE CREEK, TRIBUTARY TO THE NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD

MAXIMUM RATE/VOLUME ALLOWED: 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) OF WATER TO BE DIVERTED FROM AN UNNAMED STREAM WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM AN UNNAMED STREAM TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM MIDDLE CREEK PROVIDED THAT THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM BOTH SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.005 CFS

PERIOD OF USE: DECEMBER 1 THROUGH APRIL 30 FOR DOMESTIC USE; FURTHER LIMITED FROM MAY 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30 TO HUMAN CONSUMPTION ONLY

DATE OF PRIORITY: JANUARY 26, 1995

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 7, T28S, R11W, W.M.; UNNAMED STREAM - 20 FEET NORTH AND 30 FEET WEST; MIDDLE CREEK - 4410 FEET NORTH AND 680 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 7

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

Measurement recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the permittee to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the permittee to install a meter or other measuring device, the permittee shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the permittee shall maintain the meter or

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measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

- B. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The permittee may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate fish screening devices to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility at the time of perfection of this right.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction work shall begin within one year from permit issuance and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1999.
