SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED SPRING

TRIBUTARY OF: SOUTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO HOUSEHOLDS INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF UP TO ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN AND HUMAN CONSUMPTION FOR ONE POST OFFICE, FURTHER LIMITED, AS DESCRIBED BELOW, TO HUMAN CONSUMPTION FOR TWO HOUSEHOLDS AND ONE POST OFFICE

MAXIMUM RATE ALLOWED: 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO HOUSEHOLDS INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF UP TO ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN AND 0.005 CFS FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION FOR ONE POST OFFICE, FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.015 CFS FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION ONLY FOR TWO HOUSEHOLDS AND ONE POST OFFICE

PERIOD OF USE: POST OFFICE - YEAR-ROUND FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION AT A RATE OF 0.005 CFS

TWO HOUSEHOLDS - MAY 1 TO JUNE 15 AND OCTOBER 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30 FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION ONLY AT A RATE OF 0.01 CFS; DECEMBER 1 THROUGH APRIL 30 AND JUNE 15 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 FOR DOMESTIC USE INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF ONE HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN AT A RATE OF 0.01 CFS; FURTHER LIMITED TO HUMAN CONSUMPTION ONLY AT A RATE OF 0.01 CFS DURING THE PERIOD JUNE 15 TO SEPTEMBER 30 WHEN THE SPRING CONTRIBUTES FLOW TO THE SOUTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER.

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 26, 1995

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.; 477 FEET NORTH AND 958 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER SECTION 32

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4  
SECTION 32  
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

Measurement recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the permittee to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the permittee to install a meter or other measuring device, the permittee shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.
- B. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

#### STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
