SOURCE OF WATER: WILLAMETTE BASIN PROJECT RESERVOIRS, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625 AND PERMIT R-5363, TRIBUTARIES OF THE WILLAMETTE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 15.0 ACRES

RATE/VOLUME OF ALLOWED USE: 20.0 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR FROM STORED WATER ONLY

PERIOD OF ALLOWED USE: MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31 OR AS MAY BE FURTHER LIMITED BY THE BUREAU OF RECLAMATION WATER SUPPLY CONTRACT

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 27, 1995

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 8, T11S, R4W, W.M.; 1125 FEET NORTH AND 1825 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 8

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.5 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 ACRES NW 1/4 SE 1/4 4.0 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.5 ACRES


TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.

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- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any diversion listed on this permit, then use of water from the diversion shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of developing a point of diversion, the permittee shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area to the satisfaction of the Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife.

The use may be restricted if the quality of the source stream, namely the Willamette River, decreases to the point that it no longer meets state and federal water quality standards due to reduced flows.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of contract Water Service Contract No. 6-07-10-W1103, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The required screen is to be in place and functional <u>prior to</u> diversion of any water.

## STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

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This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction work shall begin within one year from permit issuance and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999. The reservoirs shall be filled and complete application of water shall be made on or before October 1, 2000.
