PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 150.41 ACRES AND LIVESTOCK WATER

RATE OF USE: 1.90 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 1.88 CFS FROM THE NORTH UMPQUA RIVER FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.02 CFS FROM UNNAMED SPRINGS FOR STOCKWATER.

PERIOD OF ALLOWED USE: MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31 FOR IRRIGATION; YEAR ROUND FOR STOCKWATER

DATE OF PRIORITY: SEPTEMBER 25, 1991

POINT OF DIVERSION (POD) LOCATION: SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 14, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 22, T26S, R5W, W.M.; POD 1 - 1680 FEET SOUTH AND 900 FEET EAST FROM THE CORNERS OF SECTIONS 9, 10, 15, AND 16; POD 2 - 390 FEET SOUTH AND 540 FEET EAST FROM THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 10 AND 15; POD 3 - 550 FEET NORTH AND 1640 FEET EAST FROM THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 14 AND 15; POD 4 - 160 FEET NORTH AND 540 FEET EAST FROM THE CORNER OF SECTIONS 14, 15, 22, AND 23; POD 5 - 1240 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET EAST FROM THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 10 AND 15; POD 6 - 1900 FEET SOUTH AND 150 FEET EAST FROM THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 15 AND 22

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter В. or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The permittee shall also install a fishway at the obstruction that will provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish. The required screens and fishways are to be in place and functional, and the fishway must be approved by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife before diversion of any water.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction work shall begin within one year from permit issuance and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2000.
