PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 24.40 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.302 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND AND AS FURTHER LIMITED BELOW

PERIOD OF USE: MAY 1 THROUGH JULY 31

DATE OF PRIORITY: DECEMBER 27, 1988

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 9, T 1N, R3W, W.M.; 1300 FEET SOUTH & 925 FEET WEST FROM NORTH 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 9

The irrigation of lands under this permit is limited to a maximum rate of 0.302 cfs. The maximum rate for this permit combined with that authorized under under certificates 61989 and 68520 shall not exceed a maximum cumulative total diversion rate of 1.13 cfs or a lessor amount if the above named certificates are superseded by certificates issued for a combined total of less than 1.13 cfs.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

## NE 1/4 NW 1/4 7.23 ACRES SECTION 9 TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with certificates 61989 and 68520 shall not exceed 1.13 cfs.

#### STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

Actual construction work shall begin within one year from permit issuance. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2001.
