SOURCE OF WATER: SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO THE UMPQUA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: SUPPLEMENTAL DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD INCLUDING IRRIGATION LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA

MAXIMUM RATE/VOLUME ALLOWED: 0.01 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL DOMESTIC USE INCLUDING IRRIGATION LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA AND FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.005 CFS FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION USE ONLY DURING THE PERIOD LISTED BELOW

PERIOD OF USE: DECEMBER 1 THROUGH JUNE 30 FOR SUPPLEMENTAL DOMESTIC USE INCLUDING IRRIGATION LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE IN AREA AND JULY 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30 FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION USE ONLY

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 23, 1996

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.; NORTH 4 DEGREES EAST 250 FEET FROM THE NW 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 33

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4  
SECTION 33  
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the permittee to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the permittee to install a meter or other measuring device, the permittee shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the

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watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

- B. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The required screen is to be in place and functional prior to diversion of any water.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use may be restricted if the quality of the source stream, namely the South Umpqua River, decreases to the point that it no longer meets state and federal water quality standards due to reduced flows.

#### STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.


By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction work shall begin within one year from permit issuance. Complete application of water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2001.
